WHAT IS BULLYING?

Bullying is when one child or a group of children repeatedly and deliberately picks on another child. Bullies try to control others using power and scare tactics. Girls, as well as boys, can be involved in bullying through persistent written or verbal expression, or physical conduct.

WHAT IS CYBER-BULLYING?

Intentional and repeated harm inflicted through the use of computers, cell phones, or other electronic devices.

WHEN SHOULD BULLYING BE REPORTED?

1. Someone is bullying you or
2. You witness bullying.

HOW DO YOU REPORT BULLYING AT OUR SCHOOL?

1. Tell a trusted adult in the building.
2. Write down details about the bullying incidence and turn it into the principals' or counselors' office.
3. Report it at www.reportabully.com by completing the form and submitting it online.

WHAT ARE EXAMPLES OF BULLYING?
